ATTENTION DOG OWNERS- YOU ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A DOG LICENSE FOR EACH DOG. THIS IS REQUIRED BY WI STATUTE & VILLAGE ORDINANCE *NEW LATE FEES START APRIL 1^{st.}

State law requires that you obtain a license for your dogs! If you have not obtained one, you are now beyond the deadline. Please stop in for a 2024 license. Bring in proof of the rabies vaccine. Fee: \$3 or \$8. The late Fee is \$15.00 per dog after April 1st. Violators will be turned over to Columbia County to issue fines for unlicensed dogs STARTING MAY 1st. Fines start at \$100.00 per dog.

<u>Statewide</u> <u>Tornado Drill</u> <u>April 11, 2024</u>

Tornado and Severe Weather Awareness Week in Wisconsin will take place April 11th, 2024. The Statewide drill will take place on April 20 at 1:45 p.m. and 6:45 p.m. An up and down siren signal means a fire. A steady blast indicates a tornado has been spotted. **TAKE COVER AT ONCE!** A second blast signals a second tornado. There is NOT an "all clear" signal in Friesland.
