

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Monitoring Requirements Not Met for FRIESLAND WATERWORKS

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water meets health standards. Between 12/1/2025 and 12/31/2025, we did not monitor for coliform bacteria, and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

What precautions should be taken at this time?

There are no special precautions you need to take at this time. However, it is important to remember that the quality of your drinking water during that period is not known at this time.

What was the cause of the missed monitoring requirements?

Sample was taken on time, however the delivery service company did not get the sample to the lab within the 30hr hold time.

What is being done to correct the problem?

Samples will continue to be taken in a timely manner and shipped in a timely manner as well.


When will the problem be resolved?
