Tornado & Severe Weather Awareness Week **April 13-17, 2026**

The Statewide drill will take place on April 16th at 1:45 p.m. and 6:45 p.m. At those times it is encouraged for everyone to discuss and practice their tornado safety plans. A steady blast indicates a tornado has been spotted. **TAKE COVER AT ONCE!** A second blast signals a second tornado. There is NOT an "all clear" signal in Friesland. If you hear an up and down siren signal that siren indicates a fire.
