GARBAGE CANS

BUILDING PERMITS

If you are considering any building or remodeling projects including decks, you are required to check with our Building Inspector, Ken Fennewald. DRIVEWAY PERMITS

The Village of Friesland requires any resident making any changes to the dimension, approach, or material to file for a driveway permit with the clerk's office. Please do not call General Engineering for this. WATER PROJECT

The Village of Friesland DPW and clerk's office throughout the summer will be conducting a mapping survey to locate all curb stops, water main covers, hydrants, and manhole covers. Curb stops specifically are located on the personal property side of the water line and often found in people's yards, so if you see Dan, Jason or Jill with a metal detector we are trying to locate them.
